What is EMM – Europe Media Monitor

The Joint Research Centre has produced software that gathers reports from news portals world-wide in 43 languages:

- classifies the articles
- analyses the news & extracts information
- aggregates the information
- issues alerts
- produces visual presentations of the information

EMM - NewsBrief

The public web application [NewsBrief](#) shows the hottest topics discussed during the last few minutes and hours across multiple news sources from around the world in 43 languages. Updated every ten minutes, the site groups together related news items, shows timelines and displays the biggest stories first.

EMM - NewsExplorer

This daily news summary [NewsExplorer](#) gives at the end of each day and for each of 19 languages, all news articles talking about the same event or subject. These are grouped into clusters and displayed by cluster size. Users can see the people, organisations and locations mentioned most in today's news. A map shows where today's events happened. The calendar allows to read about past events.

EMM - MedlSys

The Medical Information System [MedlSys](#) displays only those articles with interest to Public Health, grouped by disease or disease type. It analyses the news and alerts users automatically.

EMM - Labs

The web service [EMM-Labs](#) provides access to some of the new advanced analysis systems resulting from information retrieval from EMM data.
